AGREEMENT

between

THE ADAM MICKIEWICZ UNIVERSITY, POZNAŃ, POLAND

and

THE UNIVERSITY OF KRAGUJEVAC, KRAGUJEVAC, SR YUGOSLAVIA

The following agreement of co-operation between the Adam Mickiewicz University, Poznań, Poland, represented by the Rector, Professor Stefan Jurga,

and

the University of Kragujevac, Kragujevac represented by the Rector, Professor Radoslav Senić, was signed in Poznań on October 20,1998

§ 1

Co-operation will be undertaken by all research units of the Adam Mickiewicz University, and by all research units of the University of Kragujevac.

§ 2

The contracting parties declare to undertake scholarly co-operation in the fields of scientific research and develop academic contacts between faculty members of both institutions. In addition, the parties shall promote undergraduate and post graduate students' mobility by encouraging them to participate in academic courses, Summer courses and in other European programs.

§ 3

Both contracting parties declare to:

- 1) exchange experience, organise consultations and mutual visits and conduct lectures
- 2) enable young academic staff of both institutions to participate in conferences and symposia
- 3) enable young academic staff of both institutions to carry out research
- 4) co-operate in the exchange of scholarly publications and scientific materials.

8 4

The sending party covers the cost of travel to the place of destination, whereas the receiving party covers the cost of stay.

All participants of the exchange programs within the framework of this agreement shall be guaranteed equal rights granted to the staff and students by the laws and statutes in force at the receiving institution. Health insurance remains an individual responsibility of the exchange sent within the framework of the exchange program. In case of emergency, the receiving institution guarantees only the necessary medical care.

\$ 6

The program of scholarly and cultural co-operation will be regulated both in annual and long-terms protocols.

§ 7

The rector of each university shall appoint one or more professors who shall form a joint committee aiming at following up the present agreement.

§ 8

The validity of this agreement is not subject to temporal limitations. No alterations to it may be made, except by mutual consent. Both contracting parties guarantee to each other the possibility of terminating the agreement at twelve months' notice.

The text of the agreement has been written in three languages, Polish, Serbian and English, and each party has one complete set. From the legal point of view, all versions are equally valid.

§ 10

The present agreement becomes effective on the day of its signing.
